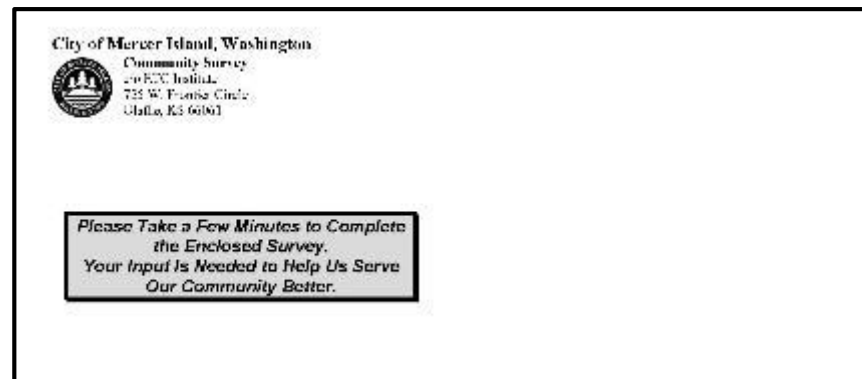

Rideshare Pilot Launches

April 23



- Six-month pilot with Lyft and Uber starts April 23, ends October 31, 2018
- 24 hrs/day, Monday-Friday
- First 3 months: flat fee of \$2 per ride
- Months 4-5: Flat fee of \$2 per shared ride, \$5 per solo ride
- All rides must start or finish at the Mercer Island Parks & Ride and cannot leave the Island
