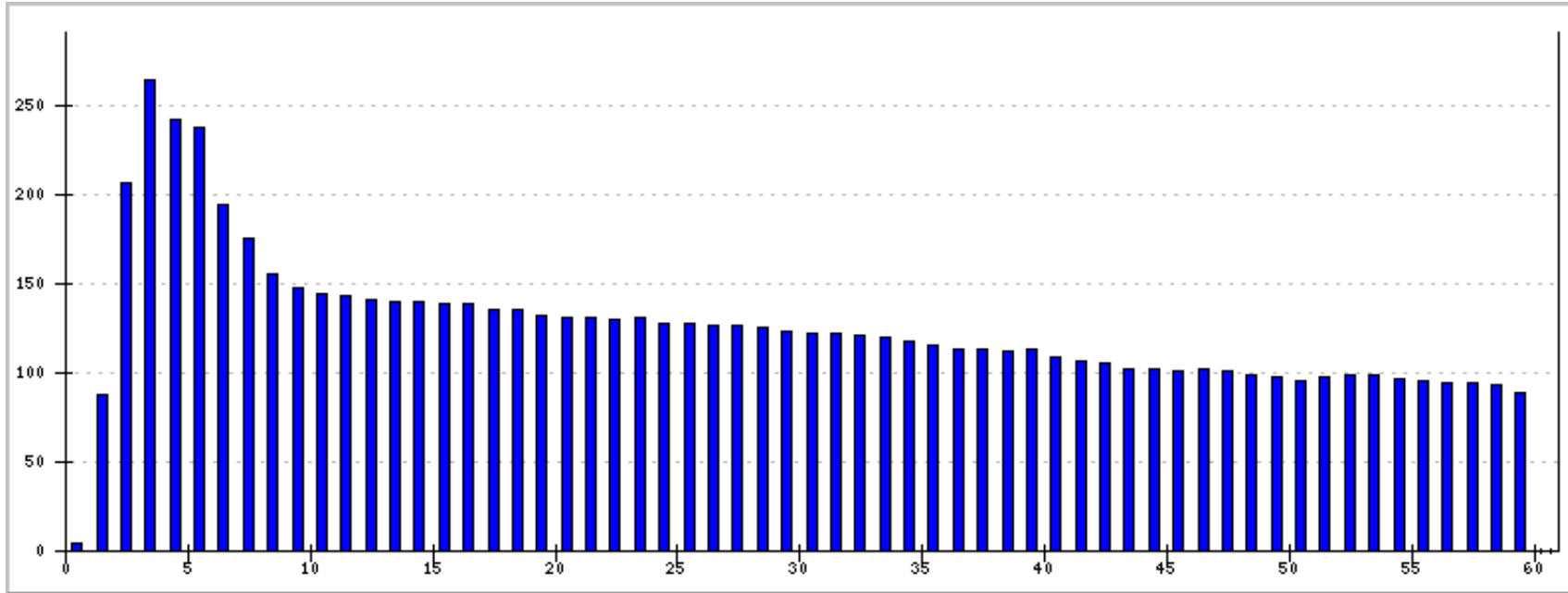
The live polls conducted during this event are non-scientific because respondents are self-selected, and may not represent the views of the broader community.

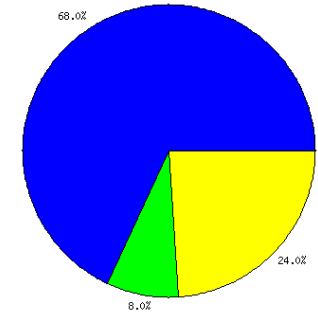

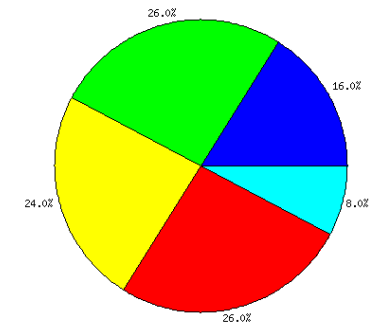
1 Overall, do you think the City provides:

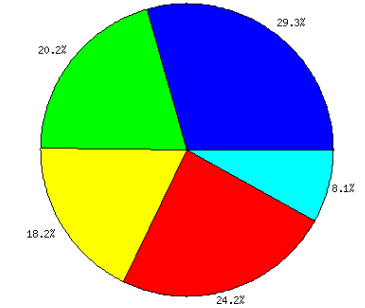
2 I would be in favor of paying more property taxes to maintain current levels of City services.

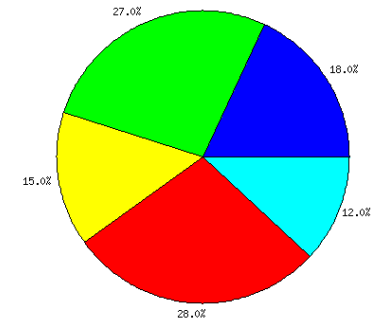

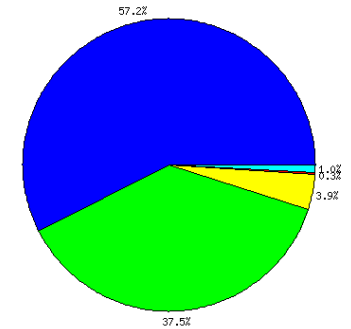

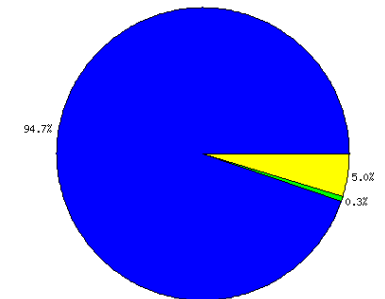
