- The consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages, drugs or cigarettes are prohibited by any parade participant. Participants are to refrain from any profanity.
- The City of Mercer Island does not accept the responsibility for traveling expenses, or food or lodging expenses of any parade participant.
- Participants are reminded to stay on course with the parade route and to refrain from mingling with or accosting parade route spectators.
- The Parade coordinator's decision regarding all entries is final. The City of Mercer Island reserves the right to reject applications.
- The City of Mercer Island reserves the right to withdraw any parade participant that does not meet the Parade Rules and Regulations.
