Fall Recycling Event A Success!

Parks Updates

- **Island Crest North Field** – Lights are in. The contractor is expecting to finish mid-December. The proposed opening celebration is the first High School varsity game in March.
- **South Mercer Playground** – First delivery of equipment arrived last week. We expect the playground to be done mid-February.
- **Clarke Beach** – Pipe is being installed for drawing water from Lake Washington for irrigation. We expect to have the water rights fully developed by spring of 2018.



Pedestrian Signal Project on Island Crest Way & SE 32nd Street

- This project installs a pedestrian signal on Island Crest Way near SE 32nd Street, providing a protected, signalized crossing.
- All work on site is finished; we are waiting for delivery of signal equipment – estimated time of delivery is 18-20 weeks.
